

**Location**

The RIBA is located at 66 Portland Place in central London, just north of Oxford Street and within easy access of underground stations.

**Underground stations**

Great Portland Street station - 4 minute walk  
(Circle, Hammersmith and City and Metropolitan Lines)

Oxford Circus station - 7 minute walk  
(Bakerloo, Victoria and Central Lines)

Regents Park - 5 minute walk  
(Bakerloo Line)

**National rail**

The national rail stations of Paddington, Euston and King's Cross are all nearby and just a few minutes journey by taxi. All of the other London terminals can be reached by underground or taxi.
